Understand how to be a good citizen and self regulate, keep trying, respond to boundaries, share, be kind and learn about each other.

Respond to a variety of books including longer stories, retelling, listening to, enjoying and engaging with them.

Independently put on and take off our coat, shoes and jumper, use the toilet and learn to ride a balance bike.
